



In the early 70s, Michael earned his A&P (Airframe and Powerplant) license, an IA (Inspectors Authorization), a CFI (Certified Flight Instructor) and Commercial Pilot's endorsement. Michael's earliest years of flying rock n' roll bands were from a basic office in a small mountain town in Southern California, called, Crestline. Within a couple of years, he had moved up the mountain to Big Bear City. With the assistance of local business investors, he started a Piper Aircraft Dealership at the local airport, while he continued to build his flying biz career. Subsequently moving to Colorado in the late '80s, he built private aircraft hangars in Durango CO and Los Alamos, NM.

Michael continued his flight consultations for major music entertainers for their private aircraft touring needs from 1977 until 2003. As of the first publication dated in his book, February 2025, Michael now lives in New England, on the border between New Hampshire/Maine, to be closer to his daughter and grandchildren. He maintains a side-business of providing digital new-age SEO content management services, while playing drums in a rock band, along with a bit of golf and competitive table tennis on the side.
